

Terms and Conditions

1. The horse trials will be run under British Eventing & SEG Competition rules unless stated in this schedule. (SEG Rules - <https://www.horse-events.co.uk/seg-rules-and-withdraw-policy/>)
2. It is compulsory that all riders' hats and body protectors comply with current British Eventing Competition rules.
3. It is compulsory that every person entering a class at Hendersyde Park Horse Trials who is under 18 years of age, is accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of the event.
4. Stop watches may be worn for the cross country phase in all classes.
5. We will allow competitors to continue on the cross country course having had three cumulative refusals on course, if they are deemed safe to do so by the Organising team, but they will incur elimination. After consultation with the Steward, they may be allowed to continue the other phases of the competition HC.
6. If a competitor has a problem at a fence, they will be allowed to miss it out and continue on the course, incurring elimination. After consultation with the Steward, they may be allowed to continue to the final phase of the competition HC.
7. Should the Organising team ask a competitor to leave the course in the interest of safety, or for any reason that they deem necessary, they will leave the course and incur elimination.
8. Should a competitor have a fall in the show-jumping, they will be eliminated and will need to be passed fit to continue by the event doctor and the Steward before being allowed to proceed to the cross country on an HC basis.
9. Should a competitor have a fall on the cross country course, they will be eliminated and not allowed to complete that phase, however once passed fit by the event doctor, they may be allowed to compete in the show-jumping phase on an HC basis with the agreement of the Steward.
10. If asked to leave the cross country course for any reason, the competitor must do so immediately and at a walk.
11. The Steward's decision is final.
12. Any competitor who has a fall must be seen by the Event doctor as soon as possible on completion of the course. The doctor will be found at the Secretary or via the Stable Manager. No competitor will be allowed to continue in the competition until passed fit to do so by the doctor and confirmed by the Steward.
13. Should a horse require attention by a vet for any reason, and the horse's connections be unavailable, we reserve the right to treat as required and move the horse to a place of safety.
14. Any veterinary work required during the competition/whilst on site at Hendersyde will be billed to the client whose horse has been treated, by Galedin Veterinary.
15. Should the event look likely to be cancelled due to adverse weather; we would ask you to check the website and BDWP for the latest news. This has only happened once in more than 20 years!
16. Should the Event have to be cancelled entry fees will be returned minus a £10 administration charge.
17. There will be no refund for on site stabling from 1st July, 2019 except in the event of cancellation of the event, when it will be refunded minus a £10 administration charge.
18. All horses and ponies must be 4 years old and over.
19. Competitors aged 10 – 12 years inclusive may only enter the 80 classes at Hendersyde. Competitors must be aged 10 at the time of entry to the competition and accompanied by an adult on the day of competition.
20. Any queries and complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organiser within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
21. Outside assistance is forbidden at any time and will result in full elimination of the competitor from the competition.
22. No ATV's/Gators/Motorised cycles are allowed on site.
23. No mucking out of lorries on site, a fine of £50 to our charities will be levied.
24. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
25. In the event of a ballot the following criteria will apply. Any incomplete entries will be removed first, followed by any third or more horses per rider. If more entries require balloting, this will be done across all entries. Priority will be given to those who entered the event early or offered help at the event.
26. Smoking is only permitted in designated external areas and is prohibited in the stable compound at any time.
27. Hendersyde Park has two official photographers on site during the event and competitors should be aware that their images may be used in print or on the Hendersyde Park website to promote the event.
28. Entry constitutes an agreement to be bound by and abide by these rules and regulations.

People must expect to have their photograph taken at many of our events and we reserve the right to publish suitable photographs of those attending, along with the names of members involved. If you do not wish for your photo to be published please inform the secretary at the individual event with your competitor number and your photo will not be taken. Entries will open on 20th June with the Ballot Date on 11th July.

The Late Entry Surcharge will commence on 14th July and Entries will close on 19th July. If classes are over-subscribed, a ballot will take place and a Wait List held for each class.

Late entries may be accepted if classes are not full Late entry fee £77.

Prizes in kind - Rosettes will be awarded to 8th place for individuals

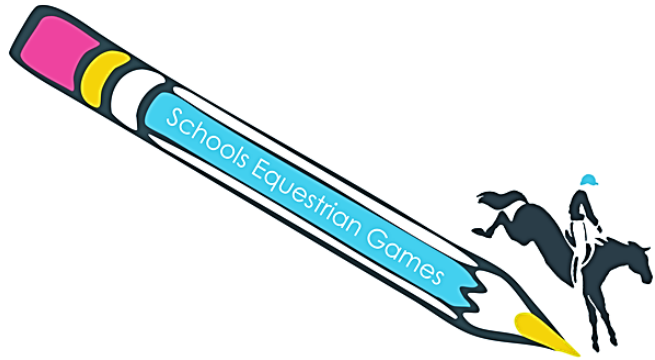
Withdrawals

Entries withdrawn before ballot date on 11th July will be refunded in full to include (on site) stabling, minus £25 admin charge. All withdrawals must be communicated in writing to the Entries Secretary. Withdrawals made on or after 11th July are at the discretion of the Organiser. If the Organiser is able to fill the withdrawn entry with another competitor in the same section, a full refund of the entry fee will be given, minus the £25 admin charge.

Schools Equestrian Games

We pride ourselves of well organised events with clear communication in a friendly and enjoyable atmosphere, providing a platform for all school children to compete in equestrian sport at all levels of competition.

The SEG Eventing Championships is a series of ODE's around the country to give children the opportunity to compete for their schools and qualify for the Schools Equestrian Games Eventing Championships.

This will be a prestigious new event for 2019 and will be the recognised Eventing Championships for all schools, we welcome international schools to compete as well.

How to Qualify

- Throughout the season the competitions are individual qualifiers -teams will then be made at the championships if schools have enough members from their school who have qualified individually to make up a team.
- Teams- Maximum of 2 teams per school per height at the championships.
- Top 8 qualify if section starters 30 or less, top 10 qualify if more than 30 starters per section.
- Qualification is passed down the line in the event that those placed have previously qualified.
- The same horse and rider combination qualify- no substitutions can be made.
- Each competitor rides for the school they currently attend - school leavers (17/18 years) ride for their previous school.
